Project Duration: 2nd November 2020 – 1st November 2022

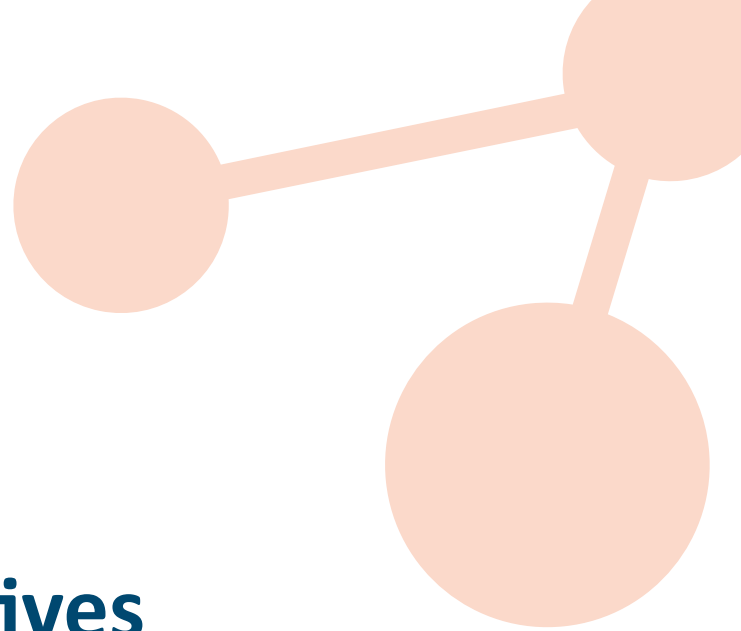
